

- e) Develop forms of communications to express, internally and externally, the characteristics expressed in direction #1.

Implementation Actions for Direction #2

- a) Use Homilies / Bible Studies / Prayer / Etc...
- b) Develop forms of communication to guide people & inform them of our faith.
- c) Continue to incorporate more music to express the intent of direction #2.

Implementation Actions for Direction #3

- a) Develop social justice awareness within the congregation (speakers, workshops, etc.)
- b) Develop social justice participation as a church (Example-St. John's Cupboard).
- c) Measure St. John's social action and report it at Vestry.
- d) Communicate St. John's social justice positions to the larger community.
- e) Continue to incorporate more music to express the intent of direction #3.
- f) Prayers and intercession.
